Discussion Questions:

-Pastor Scott said that if grace stops wrecking us (in a good way), then we'll start wrecking our world. What does it mean for grace to "wreck you"? In what areas of your life has receiving God's grace led to profound change?

-In Luke 7, Jesus said that those who have forgiven much love much. Who do you need to forgive as you've been forgiven?

-Pastor Scott said that our greatest gift to others is what we've received from God. Who do you need to give what you received from God? What do you need to give them specifically? How can this group support or encourage you in that effort?

-In Luke 24, the women left the tomb to share the good news that it was empty. In what area of your life is it most difficult to share good news or bring hope? What obstacles stand in the way?

-Pastor Scott shared about three parts to Jesus' filter - created in the image of God, person for whom Jesus had come to give His life, future Resurrected person. Who in your life is it hard to see through Jesus' filter? Where do you need to change your people filter to match His?

-If we were to go to your coworkers, neighbors, or the people who follow you online, what would they say your actions are shouting to the world?

-Pastor Scott challenged us to not compartmentalize our lives into places where our actions don't reflect the hope we profess. If we were to talk to your family, neighbors, coworkers, or friends, where would they say you struggle to NOT compartmentalize the most?
