Discussion Questions:

- Pastor Scott ended the service today with an invitation to wash the feet of another person. Did you participate? If so, what was your experience like? If you just watched others, what was your experience like?
- Based upon what God has been speaking to you about through this message and series, what do you think your next step of obedience is?

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
