- Based upon how God spoke to you through Carlos' message today, what do you feel like your next step is?
- How many of the Mastermind messages did you watch or listen to? What do you feel like God is calling you to do in light of what you heard Him speaking to you about in this series?
- How can this group pray for and support you as you renew your mind throughout the rest of 2020?
